The Topsfield Historical Society has the right to remove any offensive products that do not comply with these regulations. Please display the same type of craft throughout your booth

(For example, if you are a jeweler, please display only jewelry). Demonstrations of your craft are encouraged. No electricity is available. Please indicate the price range of your work.

Photos Judging will be based on your photographs. Please submit 1 recent photograph of display and 2 close-ups

of craft.

**Required:** Please indicate price range. **PAST EXHIBITORS MUST ALSO SUBMIT PHOTOGRAPHS.** NO EXCEPTIONS.

Photographs will be returned during registration or mailed back to you if you are not accepted.

Acceptance: ALL APPLICANTS MUST INCLUDE A SELF-ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE so that

we may

notify you on the status of your application. All entries will be reviewed by a jury. The decision of the jury is

final.

Tax Number: All craft exhibitors must have a Massachusetts Tax I.D. Number. The Massachusetts Dept. of Revenue may

be reached at (617) 887-6367. It takes six to eight weeks to receive a tax number so please plan

<u>ahead</u>.

**Show Set-Up:** Registration will begin promptly at 7:00 a.m. Any exhibitor not registered by 9:00 a.m. may forfeit their

space without a refund to an exhibitor on our waiting list.
